Our Search for Preacher/Minister Part IV

Paul instructs Timothy in 1 Timothy chapter 4 on the qualities he needed to be a good minister. He warns people not to abandon the faith and not to follow deceiving spirits. A good minister will teach people to know the truth and everything that God created is good. Paul tells Timothy to train himself to be godly. He also tells him to set an example in speech, life, love and in purity. Paul tells him to devote himself to the reading of scripture, preaching and teaching. He was instructed to use his gift, to be diligent in all these matters and to watch his life and doctrine closely.

So what should we expect from a minister? He should warn others to keep the faith and instruct the church to be careful of what they follow. It is very important he helps the church to know the truth. He is expected to be a godly man and it will be recognized by his example in life, love and in purity. The minister should be devoted to reading the scripture and dedicated to preaching and teaching. He should be willing to use his gift and watch his doctrine closely. These are just a few of the traits and qualities that we should expect from someone who wants to work with the Elders to help the church grow and be found faithful in the Lord.
