We must understand clearly what God's Word says about the men who may serve as elders and as deacons. Then we will be able to appoint such men to the roles identified, and humbly follow their lead in spiritual matters of service. Let us all be in prayer about these things, asking God's help and guidance through His Holy Spirit as we seek to be obedient disciples of Jesus Christ.</p> <p><u>The Role of Elders</u> Elders must meet and reason together to arrive at decisions regarding spiritual matters.</p> <p>Acts 15:1-2, 6-7 (NIV, ©1984) ¹ Some men came down from Judea to Antioch and were teaching the brothers: “Unless you are circumcised, according to the custom taught by Moses, you cannot be saved.” ² This brought Paul and Barnabas into sharp dispute and debate with them. So Paul and Barnabas were appointed, along with some other believers, to go up to Jerusalem to see the apostles and elders about this question. ⁶ The apostles and elders met to consider this question. ⁷ After much discussion, Peter got up and addressed them: “Brothers, you know that some time ago God made a choice among you that the Gentiles might hear from my lips the message of the gospel and believe. Such a man must be able to work together with others so appointed, and must not possess an attitude of lordship over others, to avoid creating strife and conflict. He must have the ability to oversee spiritual matters of the church, being fully familiar with the scriptures such that he is able to identify and eliminate false teaching.</p>
