Seems like things are always changing; guess that's a part of life. I'm sure glad that some things never change. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. (Hebrews 13:8) Another thing that has not changed is the very real need for Bibles in Zambia. Less than 10% of all Christians in Zambia have their own copy of the Holy Scriptures. We are working closely with Patson Syula to distribute the Bibles to new Christians and the poor churches of Christ in Zambia.

These Bibles are printed in the native language of 'Tonga. This is the tongue spoken by the native Africans which we minister to during the annual Zambia Medical Mission. Every year we distribute new Bibles to every new convert and some Bibles to the local church leadership for use in their congregations.

That brings me to the purpose of this article. Since the need for Bibles is still as great as ever, we are asking for your help. If you possibly can, please donate. Every penny that you contribute goes directly to the purchase of Bibles. Even the postage is paid from individual funds. None of the money contributed is ever used for anything other than Bibles. Many 'charities' that are out there actually give a percentage of donations to their benefactors; the rest is used for administrative costs. 100% of your donation goes for Bibles and is tax deductible. Your tax refund would make a wonderful contribution, or any amount you can afford. Each 'Tonga Bible costs \$10.

Please help us this year if you can. We could go on and on about how important this work is, but I think you also know just how important it is for every Christian to have his or her very own Bible to study and to share with friends. Please give all you can.
