## Summarizing the Role of Deacons

**2 Timothy 2:23-25** (NIV, ©1984) <sup>23</sup> Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. <sup>24</sup> And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. <sup>25</sup> Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth,

**2 Timothy 3:16-17** (NIV, ©1984) <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

**The Lord's servant is instructed how to behave to win opponents. Deacons (servants) must be familiar with the scriptures, which will thoroughly equip them for every good work. A man chosen to serve as a deacon must not be quarrelsome or flighty, but instead should seek the best interests of others and work steadfastly at his assignment. His wife should be "worthy of respect, temperate and trustworthy in everything". And, just as in the case of men chosen to serve as overseers, we must "know" them – they must not be new or mere acquaintances to the congregation.**

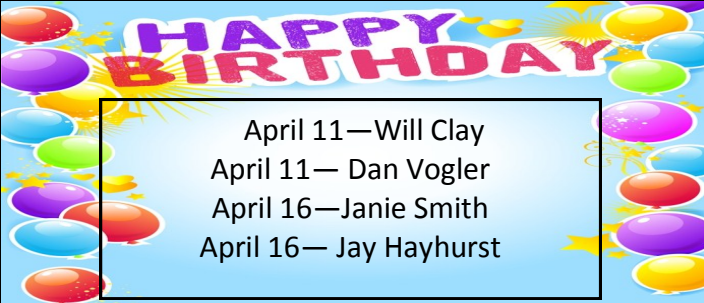
