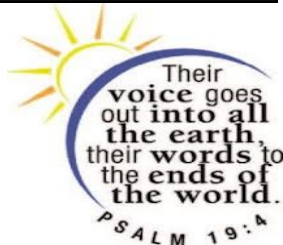

LETTER FROM THE CONWAYS

WE ARRIVED SAFELY TO ZAMBIA WEDNESDAY EVENING. WE FINALLY SLEPT THROUGH THE NIGHT LAST (FRIDAY) NIGHT AND ARE ON ZAMBIAN TIME. HERE IT IS 7 HOURS AHEAD OF TEXAS TIME. MANY NEW BUILDINGS HERE AT NAMWIANGA SINCE WE WERE HERE TWO YEARS AGO. GEORGE BENSON CHRISTIAN COLLEGE HERE AT NAMWIANGA IS GROWING AND HAS A GREAT REPUTATION IN ZAMBIA.

THERE ARE MANY CONTAINERS LINED UP ON A FIELD WITH SUPPLIES STORED FOR THE ZAMBIA MEDICAL MISSION. CONTAINER #5 IS FOR THE SPIRITUAL MISSION WORK. DARRELL FOUND 81 CASES OF BIBLES IN THE CONTAINER! THERE ARE 20 TONGA BIBLES IN EACH CASE. THANK YOU TO EVERYONE WHO CONTRIBUTED TOWARDS THESE BIBLES! HALF OF THEM WILL GO OUT WITH US DURING ZMM AND THE OTHER HALF WILL STAY AT NAMWIANGA FOR PATSON AND RODGERS TO DISTRIBUTE TO CHURCHES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

WE HAVEN'T SEEN PATSON YET. WE ARE SURE HE IS WORKING HARD FOR THE LORD. ALL OF THE ZAMBIANS WORKING ZMM WILL BE HERE SUNDAY AND WE WILL FOR SURE SEE PATSON THEN. WE HEAD OUT TO THE BUSH MONDAY MORNING FOR THE FIRST CLINIC. PLEASE PRAY FOR GOD TO USE US ALL TO HIS GLORY.
