Jason finished his course work in December of 2006. The family moved from Lubbock to Snyder to serve in the Minister Intern program at the 37th Street church of Christ. While there Jason preached every other week and as needed; developed and taught Bible Class lessons; composed weekly bulletin articles; worked with the Prison Ministry team; developed and presented devotionals for Monday Night Outreach Program and Wednesday evening services; gained some experience speaking on local Radio Ministry; and visited members and visitors. Their family really enjoyed their time in Snyder. Jason and Carolyn were able to be further involved in the Snyder community; she through her Mary Kay business and Jason as a volunteer with the Fire Department. The internship lasted 2 years and then they moved back to Magnolia at the end of February of 2009. 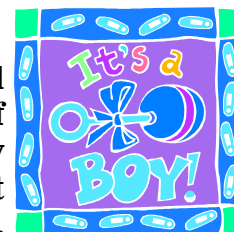
## **The Conway's leave for Zambia this Wednesday!**
