You will be deeply blessed by being with Christian sisters, praying together, studying the Bible together, encouraging church family through a card ministry and fellowshiping together!

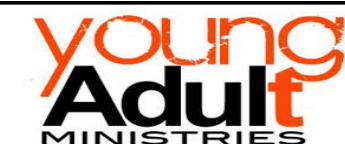
