Buffalo Gap raised \$1000 to fund Spanish Proclaimers and Hwy. 36 raised \$5000 to buy Tonga Proclaimers. We have received 100 "Proclaimers" in the Tonga language to be sent to Patson Syula in Zambia, and 20 in the Spanish (Mexican) language to be furnished to Buffalo Gap to be sent to Enrique and Aniah in Mapastepec, Chiapas, Mexico. We pray that the seed will be sown effectively in Mexico and Zambia so that lost souls will come to know Christ.</p> <p>You are also encouraged to pick up a "Kalomo Reporter" on the tables in the foyer.
