



### **Steve Ellis—Deacon of Benevolence**

Steve and other Benevolence ministry members responds to the needs of people who lack food, clothing, shelter, or financial assistance—first attention given to members of the church and their immediate families, then to residents of the surrounding community and support of children’s homes.



### **Evan Simmons—Deacon of Bible Education**

Evan organizes a team of members willing to develop plans and carry out Bible study educational classes for babies through high school age students within the Bible Education Ministry, determines the needs for teacher education, support and encouragement, consider and approve teaching materials to be used, and summer Family Vacation Bible School (VBS).



### **Bill Shaner—Deacon of Communications**

Bill Shaner plans and coordinates the use and maintenance of audio, video, security and other technologies as needed for the conduct of public worship assemblies, funerals, weddings, classroom teaching and activities within the physical premises of the church. This ministry also carries out public information and advertising for church events.



### **D.D. Southall—Ministry Leader of Fellowship**

D.D. has a team of members that plan and carry out fellowship activities to build up and encourage church members. Some of the activities include: monthly fellowship dinners; annual family retreat; annual ladies day; banquet to honor widows; Christmas party.



**David Shaner—Deacon of Finance**

David maintains the prudent record keeping and reporting of all financial contributions and disbursements of the church. This ministry enables the church to effectively manage financial support of a number of service and ministry activities locally and abroad, and to keep its members informed of the use of its financial resources.



**Lee Knox—Ministry Leader of Missions**

Lee has a team of members who are interested in the ministry of the gospel in foreign mission efforts. Ministry responsibilities include the review and analysis of mission support requests, request regular communication from supported missions and missionaries, determine the annual or periodic financial commitments to be recommended to the elders, and to make regular and frequent reports to the congregation about mission ministry activities.



**Tony Thompson—Deacon of Physical Facilities**

Tony and a team of workers ensures the upkeep and maintenance of all buildings and physical facilities of the church, including the scheduling and conduct of regular work projects of buildings, yards and parking lot areas to prevent deterioration and make needed improvements.



**Trent Gee—Deacon of Public Worship**

Trent schedules and assigns duties for all public worship assemblies, encourages the involvement of an many men as possible in worship assembly participation and leadership, and coordinates the weekly preparation of communion.



**Kole King—Deacon of Safety and Security**

Kole has a team of members willing to conduct regular periodic safety and security checks of all physical facilities, including locking mechanisms, fire extinguishers, emergency exits, mechanical/structural issues that may affect the security and safety of people.



**Brad Barron—Deacon of Transportation**

Brad will ensure the upkeep and maintenance of all vehicles owned and used by the church members for transportation to church-sanctioned events and activities. He also schedules training for approved drivers in coordination with insurance requirements and church policy guidelines.



**Gary Vannoy—Deacon of Youth**

Gary has a team of adult sponsors and parents that are known to be long-standing and faithful members of the church who are willing to host youth gatherings and devotionals, sponsor travel events, mentor youth and children in the development as Christians.
