From the shepherd's pen: "What do you believe?" This is a famous question line in one of the Indiana Jones movies. The question was posed at a critical time in the life of the character. It's an appropriate question for you and me to consider today. "In God We Trust" may be the official motto of the United States, but belief in God appears to be on the decline. Recent 2019 research found that 4% of American adults identify as atheists and 5% as agnostics, compared with 2% atheists and 3% agnostics in 2009. Another 17% of Americans describe their religion as "nothing in particular" in the survey, up from 12% in 2009. What about those of us who say "I believe in God"? Is this an adequate statement of belief? James, the brother of Jesus and leader of the 1st century church in Jerusalem, wrote these inspired words: "You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder." (James 2:19). Obviously, saying we believe is only the start of living, talking and treating others in ways that prove we believe God is the God of all creation. James went on to write about proving our belief by the things we do. Do I love others as much as I love myself? Do you obey God's will? Do we revere God's holy word by immersing ourselves in the study of it? Are we aware of every word that comes out of our hearts and mouths? You see, it's one thing to say "I believe"; it's more important to live as a believer. What do you believe - anything in particular?
