From the shepherd's pen:

The apostle Paul addresses a serious problem plaguing the Christians of Galatia in his letter to the churches in that area of the world. You see, many of the brothers and sisters in Christ had 'deserted Him...for a different gospel' (Galatians 1:6)! These were people who had heard the true gospel of Jesus, had believed from their hearts the message of salvation through nothing else but the blood of Christ and the power of His resurrection from the dead...but now were falling prey to the distortion of this message. They were being taught by false teachers (2:4-5) that even obedient believers to this true gospel had to submit to the conditions of the Old Law of regulations, particularly with regard to circumcision, or else lose their salvation. How could sensible people be convinced of such bindings when they had experienced freedom in Christ? The simplicity of the gospel of Christ must never be compromised. May we always keep in mind the inspired words of Paul in Galatians 1:10: "For am I now seeking the favor of men, or of God? Or am I striving to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ."
