From the shepherd's pen: To all the young people who are old enough to read and understand this, but young enough to still be dependent on their parents: God has made His expectations very clear for us in His word. **Children are to obey and honor their parents.** Here's what this means - if your father asks you to help him with a yardwork project, do it. If your mother asks for your help with the dishes or preparing a meal, do it. If your parents tell you what time you must be home from your friends' house, do it. When your father and mother tell you they expect you to be on your best behavior, then be on your best behavior. When your parents pray for your safety and good health, know that they mean it. Why should you do all this? Because when you do you will have not only been obedient but will have demonstrated that you honor them as well. So then, what's in it for you?

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother (which is the first commandment with a promise), so that it may be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth." (Ephesians 6:1-3)

Do you want to do what is right? Do you want to enjoy a good life, and live long? Then obey and honor your parents! If you haven't been obedient or honorable to them, you can decide to change course. Ask God to remind you; ask a trusted friend for help; go to your parents and apologize when you disobey them, and ask them to forgive you. They will know you are trying. You will discover God's promise is true, and He is faithful to keep His promises.



Over the course of the last year and a half, we as a church have found ways to adapt to unusual circumstances for worship, meeting, communicating, and even our giving. One way we adapted was by establishing an electronic means for financial giving through the Google Pay app. In recent months this resource has changed its format in such a way that has interrupted our ability to continue its use. After considering other options, we will not be setting up a new venue for electronic giving as the need for such is no longer pressing. If you are unable to attend services, feel free to send a check via mail to the church address or set up an automatic payment through your personal bank.
