From the shepherd's pen: We know from the historical accounts contained in God's word that people reject God. **Adam and Eve rejected Him** ("then the Lord God said to the woman, 'What is this you have done?' And the woman said, 'the serpent deceived me, and I ate.'" - Genesis 3:13); **almost the entire Israelite nation rejected Him** ("the Lord said to Samuel, 'Listen to the voice of the people in regard to all that they say to you, for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me from being king over them.'" - I Samuel 8:7); **even King Saul rejected Him** ("therefore I said, 'Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and I have not asked the favor of the Lord.'" So I forced myself and offered the burnt offering.' Samuel said to Saul, 'You have acted foolishly; you have not kept the commandment of the Lord your God,'" - I Samuel 13:12-13). **People continue to reject Him even today.**

Some reject God and the good news of salvation through His Son Jesus; others reject the truth of God's holy word regarding His promises; still others reject Him because they are led away to something else they see as more attractive, more exciting, more emotionally appealing. Look around you; some of our own have rejected Jesus, and are chasing other pursuits - much like those described by Paul in I Timothy 1:19: "keeping faith and a good conscience, which some have rejected and suffered shipwreck in regard to their faith." Brothers and sisters, if we reject God's word, or Jesus Christ, or the commandments of God, we can be certain of our shipwreck in regard to our faith. **May we all take a good look at our hearts, to examine ourselves with eternity in mind;** and may we determine to faithfully follow after the life that is only found in Christ!
