From the shepherd pen:

In last week's message, we discussed how, from the very beginning of man's existence, humans have rejected God. This issue has been on my mind much this past week. It's one thing to see from God's historical accounts the names of people who, although they knew God and His mighty saving acts, chose to reject Him - but it becomes much more personal when we take a look around us and see people we know and love who reject Him. Maybe you have family members, or neighbors, or close personal friends who demonstrate their rejection of God by the manner in which they live. Maybe your son or daughter, or father or mother, has turned his/her back on the Almighty God of all creation. They no longer serve the only true and living God, but instead live only to please themselves. What are we to do or say?

The Lord inspired the apostle Paul to write these words to the Galatians, some of whom had come to know God and then turn their backs on Him: *"However at that time, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those which by nature are no gods. But now that you have come to know God, or rather to be known by God, how is it that you turn back again to the weak and worthless elemental things, to which you desire to be enslaved all over again?" (4:8-9). Those of our loved ones who are in this situation must be reminded by the Hebrew writer's warning: "For if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a terrifying expectation of judgment and the fury of a fire which will consume the adversaries." (10:26-27). Let us pray that God will guide our hearts and minds to use the truth of His word to gently instruct those who are rejecting the only Savior. May He open their hearts to be receptive, and may they turn in repentance to His loving arms of salvation, living lives that are holy and upright for as long as they live!*
