From the shepherd pen:

"Who are you?" Have you ever been asked that question? It can be a startling one, especially if asked by someone who should know the answer. In the Old Testament, an old and blind Isaac asked this question of his son Jacob (Genesis 27). Jacob answered untruthfully, maliciously saying that he was the older brother Esau. Again, we are told that Joshua asked this question of the Hivites, people who inhabited Gibeon. They craftily tricked Joshua and the Israelite leaders into making a peace covenant with them so that they would not be defeated - a peace covenant that was made without reliance on the Lord (Joshua 9). The answers given to this question were lies, on both occasions.

In the New Testament, the priests and Levites asked John the Baptizer **"Who are you?"** He gave a truthful answer, by saying that he was not the Christ. They pressed him further, demanding that he tell them who he was. His response? *"I am a voice of one crying in the wilderness, 'Make straight the way of the Lord'" (John 1:23). Saul of Tarsus asked the question in Acts 9 - but he already knew the answer! "Who are you, Lord?" When Paul later recounted this same life-changing event as recorded in Acts 22, and again before King Agrippa and Festus (Acts 26), he made it clear that he knew it was the Lord Jesus Christ. And the answer given him was the truth (Acts 9:5). As followers of the Lord Jesus, let's be sure to be truthful in answering! So...Who are you?*

Don't forget our special Thanksgiving Devotional on Wednesday, November 24 at 7 p.m. There will be no separate Bible classes that evening; everyone will gather in the auditorium for a time of prayer, singing and reading of the Word of God - all lifted up in thanksgiving to our heavenly Father.
