From the shepherd's pen:

After Elisha dies in approximately the year 800 B.C., no other miracles performed by a man of God are recorded. Acts of God continue to occur but the prophets' ministry changes. The next 16 prophets issue warnings, instructions, or encouragement. But one of the most important messages they give is about the coming of the Messiah. Each one of them gives a clue about Jesus; who He is, who He will be, how you will know Him, even what He will look like! Even Joel, possibly the last recorded prophet, tells of when to expect Him.

In 30 A.D., the people know these words well and they are waiting and looking. John, the baptizer, also knows the scriptures and sends men to ask Jesus, "Are you the one who was to come, or should we expect someone else?" Jesus answered, "Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard. The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor.... What did you go out to the desert to see?... A prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet..." (Luke 7:18-28)
