From the shepherd's pen:

Usually we think of Jonah as a children's Bible story about a man of God who has a bad attitude, told to go preach to evil Nineveh by The Lord, and only goes after disobeying and being punished for 3 days in a fish.

This is the story we tell about Jonah.

But it isn't the story that Jesus tells about Jonah.

Jesus describes Jonah as a "sign to the Ninevites" whose preaching caused an entire generation of people to be saved. Because of Jonah, not only did those men of Nineveh repent but at the judgment they will testify that the generation at Jesus's time will be condemned (Luke 11:29-32). As bad as Nineveh was, Israel is currently worse.

So 600 years later, Jesus doesn't mention Jonah's disobedience and attitude. Jesus credits him with saving people whose hearts were changed and turned to The Lord.

If Jonah had known his name would have been spoken by Jesus would he have acted and thought differently? In the same way, Jesus says He will speak your name if you speak His Name (Luke 12:8).

Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account. Do this so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no benefit to you. Hebrews 13:17
