From the shepherd's pen:

We live in a world of worry. This month we are
going to focus on the topic of worry from the Chris-
tian perspective. When trouble arises, instead of
giving in to worry, focus on these three "R's":

RECOGNITION: Recognize we do not have to deal
with trouble alone. Jesus says "Come unto Me all
that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you
rest." (Matthew 11:28)

REALIZATION: Realize that God is able to help you
deal with any issue that comes your way. Paul
declares "What shall we say then, if God is for us,
who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31)

REVERENCE: Praise and glorify God for His deliv-
erance (even before it happens!) See Paul's reac-
tion to God dealing with his difficulties that had
caused him so much anxiety. (II Corinthians 1:10)

Focus on God instead of the trouble, and see what
happens to your worry!
