From the shepherd's pen:

Romans 12:4-5: For just as we have many parts in one body and all the body's parts do not have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually parts of one another. When the body is healthy we rejoice and when it hurts or is broken we go to extraordinary measures to repair it. The arms and legs are not as useful when the back is hurting, but the arms and legs are still parts of one another and the body head is Christ.

Colossians 1:18: He is also the head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything.

The Church being the body of Christ has many moving parts and we have many people who have committed themselves to that body of which Christ is head. There are many committed people who work hard and exercise themselves for that body and the rest of the body is thankful. But none of us can do what all of us can do. And we cannot wear out the part that is trying to carry the whole load. Unity and commitment matters to your body, and so it does to the body of Christ, that body needs your part. God gave everybody a gift, (Romans 12:6) exercise them accordingly. You know what it is, and when you use it that gift grows and the whole body benefits.

Romans 12:10 Be devoted (committed) to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted in prayer.
